Summer's almost here and the RGHA swimming pool will open April 30th. Keys will be distributed at the April 27th annual meeting to all owners whose dues are paid up. If you can't attend the meeting, **please contact Gail Simons at 526-3526 to obtain one.** There's no charge when you turn in last year's key in exchange for the new one. Otherwise, it's \$5 to cover the cost of updating the locks and making new keys.

Please be considerate at the pool On warm summer days

The RGHA swimming pool is a popular place for families to relax and neighbors to gather and socialize. Please be considerate about bringing guests. The pool is for RGHA residents to enjoy — homeowners and renters who have a key. It's OK to bring a couple of friends but let's not spoil it by crowding the pool area with outsiders.

2016 Pool Rules

Hours: Pool hours on school nights, Sunday through Thursday, until the end of school in June and after school begins in August are **7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.** Pool hours during the summer break from June until school begins in August are **7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.**

Quiet Time : *Our neighbors whose homes border the pool area are grateful for Quiet Time after 9:00 p.m. during the summer swim season.*

Swim Attire: Only proper swim attire is permitted. Please, NO jeans, cut-offs or paper diapers. Fibers from these items can severely clog the pool filtration system.

Pool Toys & Inflatables: Please be courteous and keep to a minimum when the pool is busy.

Supervision: Children under 14 MUST NOT BE IN THE POOL AREA without an adult over 18 years of age. This is a State Law.

Guests: Only adult members, 18 years and over, may bring guests. No usage of the pool area for outside parties is allowed. Please do not bring guests when the pool is crowded. Homeowners MUST be present with their guests.

Parental Supervision: Parents are liable at all times for the actions of their minor children. Any vandalism by children of a homeowner will be the financial responsibility of the homeowner. Please be aware that there is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY AT ANY TIME.

Restrooms: Please help maintain the facilities by keeping them clean. Any soiled diapers should be put in the large garbage can outside.

Access: You must have your pool key with you to gain access to the pool area. Please do not ask for someone inside the pool area to let you in, and if you're in the pool area, please do not let anyone in who does not have his or her key. Please be sure that the gate closes fully when entering and exiting the facility.

NO DOGS, GLASS, ALCOHOL, SMOKING, BIKES, SKATE-BOARDS, OR ROLLERBLADES IN THE POOL AREA AT ANY TIME.

Our lovely pool belongs to all of us and must be treated with the same consideration as if it were in your own backyard. The right to use these facilities carries with it the responsibility to use them properly. We are liable for our own actions and use the pool at our own risk. Any member has the right and obligation to enforce the pool rules, including reporting vandalism to the police.
